

#### Clocks


We use clocks to tell us the time. What are these parts of the clock called?



#### Clocks



We use clocks to tell us the time.



The small hand tells us what hour it is.

We call this the hour hand.

The big hand tells us how many minutes past or to each hour it is. We call this the minute hand.


When the minute hand points straight up to the number 12, this tells us that it is an 'o'clock' time.

This is when a new hour starts.


We use clocks to tell us the time.




### What Time Is It?

## Half past

When 30 minutes have passed and the minute hand is pointing to the 6, we say:

half past ½ past



The hour hand will also be half way between numbers.

Be sure you read the number that the hour hand has passed!







Quarter past

When 15 minutes have passed and the minute hand is pointing to 3, we say:

quarter past ¼ past



Remember to read the number that the hour hand has passed!

Quarter past 9



Quarter past 1

Quarter past 3

### Quarter to

When 45 minutes have passed and the minute hand is pointing to 9, there are 15 minutes until the next hour. We say:

quarter to ¼ to



Remember to read the number that is ahead of the hour hand!
