Why do we come to school?



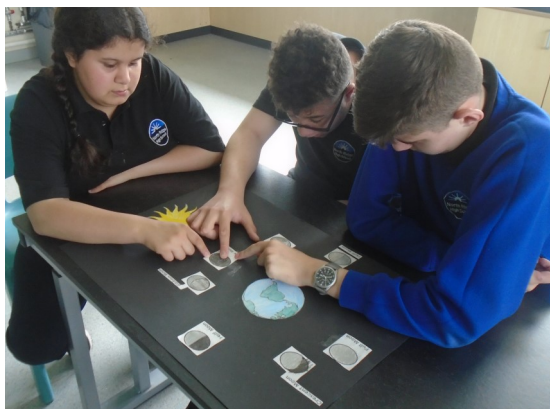
All pupils have a right to an education.

good night's sleep.



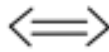
3. Set an alarm for the morning.

5. Book holidays out of school term time.



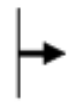
How school can help attendance:

2. Check why a pupil is absent from school.



3. Acknowledge good attendance from pupils with
