Who are we?



We are a team of health professionals working together to support families affected by the COVID-19 pandemic

We have the following services in our team:

- Occupational Therapy
- Physiotherapy
- Speech and Language Therapy
- Special School Nursing Service
- CAMHS – Clinical Service for Children with Disabilities

What do we do?



We work together with; families, carers, health colleagues and education staff to provide short term, joined up advice and support over telephone or video consultation

We aim to help your family if you are finding that your child's or young person's behaviour challenging, or where there has been a change in your child's needs or abilities, as a result of the pandemic

What will happen?



Following a team discussion we may agree on one or more of the following:

- Contact you for more information
- Liaise with services already involved
- Create a plan of support with input from: therapy, nursing and CAMHS as required
- Referral on to another service

You can then contact the service in the future if your child or young person's needs change

Children and young people who attend a Manchester Special School who;

- Have a Manchester GP
- Are experiencing difficulties due to the pandemic
